

WHAT HAPPENS TO FOOD WASTE?



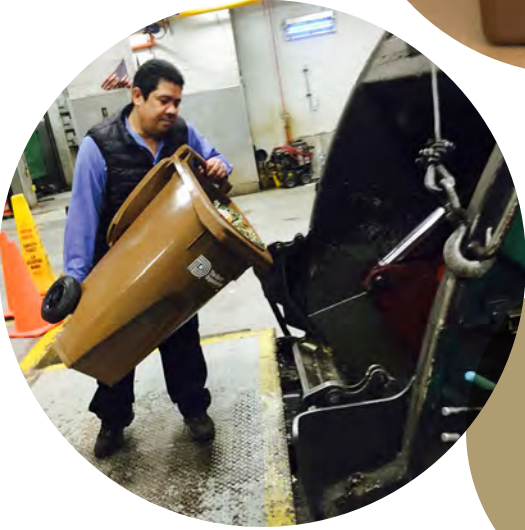

Organic waste is collected in small bins located in every office pantry.

The Durst Organization building staff collects the organic waste from the pantries and combines it in a large toter.

The organic waste is picked up by a hauler and transported to a collection facility.



The food waste is sorted for any non-organic contaminants.

The organics are transported to partner processing facilities, including McEnroe Organic Farm.

At McEnroe Organic Farm, the organics are converted into compost over a period of 8-10 months.

Finished compost is taken out of the curing and staging area and is screened to separate any contaminants.

Finished compost is used in home gardens and even makes its way back to New York City as a soil amendment for The Durst Organization green roofs.
